

# The making of the Murano.



Murano starts with individual glass bars, then the artisans hand cut and separate glass by color and shape. Strips are then put together by hand to form each individual piece of the Murano collection. During production, pieces are fused together and once the fusion process is complete the individual pieces are then separated by color, size and finish. Individual pieces then pass through quality control before being packaged.



Elida Glass has more the 20 glass artists working exclusively on the Murano glass collection.
